» Executive Committee of Council - Re: 2022 Bursary Award Program

» Financial Management Committee - Re: Major Civic Building Projects Status Update

City Council received a detailed update on the status of 7 major civic building projects. The Burnaby Lake Aquatic and Arena Facility, Willingdon/Brentwood Community Centre Redevelopment, Confederation Park Community Centre, Cameron Community Centre and Library, and Fire Hall #8 are in the detailed design phase, while Rosemary Brown Arena and Laurel Street Works Yard projects are now in the construction phase.
