## **» 5.1 Executive Committee of Council - Re: Development Approval Review Process - KPMG Report Recommendations**

City Council received a detailed report from KPMG, which included several recommendations to improve the City's Development Approval Review Process (DARP). Additionally, Council authorized the creation of three new regular full time positions and one regular part time position to support the DARP project. The goal of DARP is to reduce the time it takes to have projects approved, and to simplify the City's approval process to make it clearer and more transparent, and hence more accessible for applicants.

## **» 6.7 Temporary Use Permit #22-05 - Proposed Ping Pong and Table Tennis Club**

City Council issued a temporary use permit for 7000 Lougheed Highway, to allow a non-profit ping pong and table tennis club in the existing commercial retail unit on the property for a period of up to three years.

## **» 6.9 Unsightly Property at 4449 Georgia Street**

City Council authorized staff to enter onto a property at 4449 Georgia Street in order to remove and dispose of any overgrowth, materials or debris contributing to the unsightliness of the property at the expense of the property owner. This property has been the subject of 13 complaints since 2017. City staff have previously conducted clean up on the property in 2021.

## **» 6.11 Contract Award - 2022 Local Area Service Program and Upgrades Program**

City Council awarded a contract to Mainland Construction Materials ULC dba Winvan Paving for a total cost of \$1,039,346.70, to complete pavement restoration, road and utility upgrades of multiple roadways including the following works:

- 4,130 square metres of full depth milling;
- 4,130 square metres of upper and lower course asphalt;
- 510 metres of asphalt curb; and
- Street-lighting upgrades.
