» **[6.1 Water Metering for Small Scale Multi-Unit Housing](#)**

City Council directed staff to prepare a strategy to outline how the City can introduce residential water metering. City Council also authorized the City Solicitor to bring forward bylaw amendments to require the installation of water meters in all new residential and commercial developments, effective July 1, 2024.

» **[6.4 CA - Electric Automated Side Load Refuse Truck](#)**

City Council approved the purchase of one electric side load garbage truck. Through Provincial and Federal programs, the City is eligible to receive up to \$300,000 in rebates on this purchase.

» **[10.1 Parkland Refinery Incident Cost Recovery](#)**

City Council received an update from staff on the feasibility of recovering costs related to the emergency response at Parkland Refinery on January 21, 2024. The City will seek to recover \$28,963.54 from Parkland for the City's response.
