
Notice is hereby given pursuant to section 40 of the *Community Charter*, that a proposed Highway Closure Bylaw be presented before City Council for final adoption at the regular Council Meeting scheduled on **November 6, 2023.**

BYLAW NAME: Burnaby Highway Closure Bylaw No. 5, 2023 (Road Closure #23-04)

Purpose: To close certain portions of highway – closure of a portion of Southridge Drive and Byrnepark Drive (those portions of road dedicated in: (a) District Lot 155A, Group 1, New Westminster District, by Plan LMP30202, and containing 758.8 m², identified as Parcel A and shown heavily outlined; (b) District Lot 155A, Group 1, New Westminster District, by Plan 1425, and containing 94.2 m², identified as Parcel B and shown heavily outlined and hatched; (c) District Lot 155A, Group 1, New Westminster District, by Plan EPP122272, and containing 150.4 m², identified as Parcel C and shown heavily outlined and cross-hatched; (d) District Lot 155A, Group 1, New Westminster District, by Plan 1425, and containing 42.1 m², identified as Parcel D and shown heavily outlined and plus hatched; and (e) District Lot 171, Group 1, New Westminster District, by Plan 992, and containing 20.0 m², identified as Parcel E and shown heavily outlined and zig zag hatched, on Reference Plan EPP122274 prepared by Gary Rowbotham, B.C.L.S.
