» **7.1 Public Safety Committee - RE: Burnaby Bylaw Enforcement Policy**

City Council approved the implementation of Burnaby's Bylaw Enforcement Policy, which explains in plain language how and when Burnaby staff enforce the City's bylaws.

» **7.4 Executive Committee of Council - RE: Eco-Sculpture Gift to First Nations**

City Council voted in favour of gifting eco-sculptures to the four host First Nations on whose traditional territory the City of Burnaby is located: səl̓il wətəʔt (Tsleil-Waututh) Nation, xʷməθkʷəʔyəm (Musqueam) Nation, Skwxwú7mesh Úxwumixw (Squamish) Nation, and kʷikʷəł̓əm (Kwikwetlem) Nation, after initial Council-to-Council meetings.

» **8.1 Enhanced Public Education for AAP and GRO Project**

City staff provided an update to City Council regarding the upcoming Alternative Approvals Process (AAP) to remove parkland dedication to build a new Green Recycling and Organics facility (GRO). City staff will be creating a public education campaign to better inform residents about the AAP process, which will include two open house sessions where residents can ask questions to the project team.
