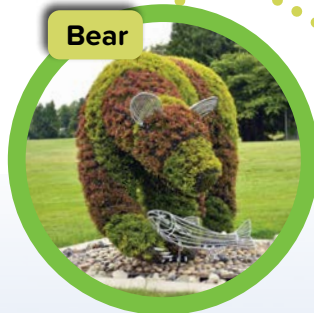

Every summer Eco-sculptures are placed throughout Burnaby. How many can you find?

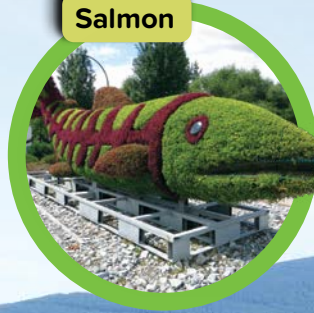

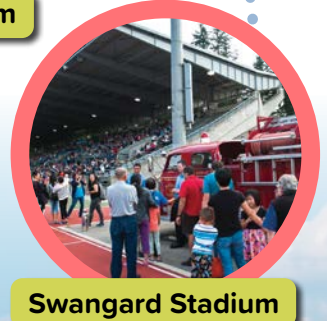
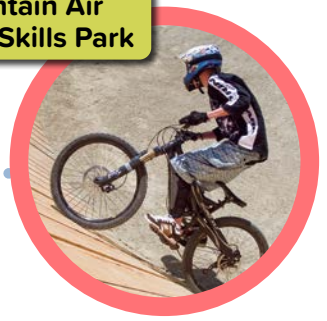
