#### Flea Market Hours

- Setup begins at 8am
- Hours of operation are 9:30am 1:30pm

Vendors are required to stay at their table until 1:30pm – packing up early may result in not being able to register at future Confederation Flea Markets

Refreshments will be available for purchase at the Coffee Bar

# Registration Requirements

- Reviewing the Vendor Guidelines when you register is mandatory to participate in this Flea Market
- Registration will remain open until tables are fully booked. In the event all tables are booked, you are permitted to waitlist
- There is a limit of 1 table per person. Table size is 6ft x 2.5ft (180cm x 75cm)
- Vendors are responsible for choosing their table at time of registration or one will be assigned
- · Goods must be lightly used or hand crafted

# The following Goods are not permitted:

- Retail Merchandise including Home Business products Oils, Tupperware, Watkins etc.
- · Perishable goods including but not limited to preserves, canned goods and baked goods
- Car Seats or Booster Seats are not permitted to be sold.

Vendors attempting to sell these items will be required to remove them from their table We reserve the right to ask Vendors to remove items for sale

### **Set Up Requirements**

- Vendors will be allowed to set up beginning at 8am (entrance through designated doors)
- Vendors must arrive no later than 9am. Table set up must be completed no later than 9:15am
- Vendor name tags must be worn until 9:30am to gain entrance in and out of the building
- To ensure parking space is available to purchasers, we ask that you unload your items and then park your car in the surrounding parking areas away from the front and back parking lots
- Sales space is limited to your assigned table area only. Only items fitting on, under or behind one's table will be permitted
- Aisles must remain safe and accessible (no tripping hazards or clutter) strictly enforced
- No Vendor owned tables may be set up by the Vendor, only Centre provided tables may be used
- Tables may NOT be moved from their assigned position
- If there is a wall behind your table, you may use Centre approved tape to adhere light weight items to the wall
- Coat racks can only be used on certain tables at the end of aisles. Supplies including coat racks, tape, or change for items sold must be brought by the vendor

# **Security**

• The security of merchandise and valuables are the sole responsibility of the vendor

### **Clean Up Requirements**

- Vendors are responsible for the cleanup of their table
- The Centre does not guarantee that items may be left for donation. Vendors will be advised at sign in, the day of the Flea Market if donation pick up is available
- · Any items left for donation must be in a closed box or tied bag, no loose items will be accepted

By registering for this market it indicates you have read the above guidelines. Non-compliance of the above guidelines will result in forfeiture of attendance at future Confederation Flea Markets.
