» **[7.1 Proposed 2025 Lease Rate and Grants for Community Resource Centres](#)**

City Council approved granting below-market lease rates to non-profit organizations operating out of civic facilities.

» **[7.4 Interim Guidelines and Procedures for Naming Civic Assets](#)**

City Council received the interim report outlining new procedures for naming civic facilities, such as parks, recreation centres and trails. The guidelines outline a process prioritizing inclusion, equity and Indigenous representation for the naming of future assets. A final report will be delivered to council outlining the full policy in the coming months.

» **[6.1 Child Care Grant Funding](#)**

City Council approved a grant of \$664,000 to support 24 new infant/toddler child care spaces at Burnaby North Secondary. To date, the City has supported the development of 7 child care centres on or adjacent to school sites throughout the community that have created a total of 247 spaces for children aged 5 and under.

» **[8.1 Building Permit Tabulation Report - August 1-31, 2024](#)**

City Council received a report outlining the number of building permits issued from August 1 to August 31 of this year. The City issued 77 total permits during this period, and has issued 576 permits to date in 2024.

» **[8.2 Major Engineering Projects Update](#)**

City Council received a report outlining the progress on 6 major City-led engineering projects. The report provides an update on the following projects: Marine Drive: Greenall Avenue to Strathearn Avenue; two sidewalk expansion programs at Alpha Secondary School and along 6th Street; the Burnaby Lake Overpass; the SFU Evacuation Route; and the Burnaby Lake Southeast Greenway.

» **[8.2 Major Civic Building Projects Update](#)**

City Council received a report outlining the progress on 12 major civic projects underway across the city. Of note, Fire Station 4 is complete, the Kensington Rink Slab Replacement project is complete, and Fire Station 8 is expected to be complete later this year.
