» 6.1 M'akola Housing Society - Housing Agreement for 7000 Lougheed Highway

City Council authorized staff to enter into a Housing Agreement with M'akola Housing Society to facilitate the development of non-market housing as part of a planned development at 7000 Lougheed Highway. The development will include 66 non-market units.

» 6.2 Holdom Overpass Project - Expropriation of portions of 5595 Roy Street

City Council directed staff to move forward with expropriation of portions of 5595 Roy Street to facilitate the construction of the new Holdom Overpass. The overpass is being constructed by Vancouver Fraser Port Authority to improve north-south transportation connections in Burnaby and eliminate a level rail crossing. The City will own the overpass upon completion.

» Release of Closed Meeting Decision – New City Hall

City Council released a decision from a closed meeting held earlier in the day on September 9. Based on policy advice and recommendations, City Council reconfirmed its decision to no longer consider renovating the current City Hall building due a variety of reasons including cost, the challenges of relocating staff and operations and the fact that the renovated building would still be too small to meet the needs of our growing city. Staff have been asked to bring forward options in the coming months for a new City Hall building in the Deer Lake area.
