» 6.1 Confederation Park Community Centre Project

City Council voted to abandon the Confederation Park Community Centre redevelopment project and cancel the existing contracts awarded through the public bid process, due to rising costs and funding challenges. Council further directed staff to return with a report on the scope and possible timing of taking on a different project to address the Confederation Park Community Centre needs in the future. The City will move forward with the Brentwood Community Centre project to meet the recreation needs of residents in Burnaby's northwest quadrant.

» 6.2 Mintara atop Burnaby Mountain Patio Expansion

City Council considered the report recommendation to abandon the project due to costs and funding challenges but voted to continue with the patio expansion project at Mintara atop Burnaby Mountain due to the amount already invested in the project. The new, glass-enclosed patio area will add an additional 2,000 sq. ft. of dining space and 50 seats. The design also includes a complete bar, a barbecue section and basement storage space.

» 8.3 Building Permit Tabulation Report - From December 1 - December 31, 2024

City Council received a report outlining the number of building permits issued from December 1 to December 31 of 2024. The City issued 92 total permits during this period and issued a total of 986 permits in 2024, representing a value of \$1.7 billion.

» 12.1 Councillor Gu - Proposed Motion: Bike Playground
