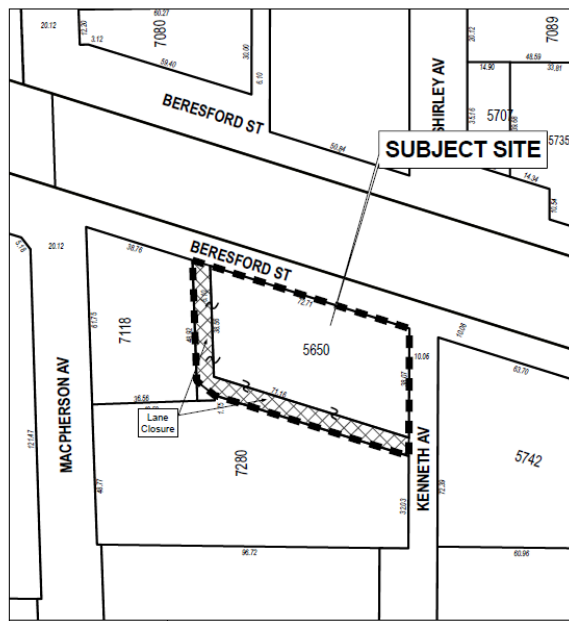


Public Notice: Highway Closure Bylaw

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to section 40 of the *Community Charter*, the following proposed Highway Closure Bylaw will be presented before City Council for final adoption at the regular Council Meeting scheduled on **March 25, 2025**.

BYLAW NAME: Burnaby Highway Closure Bylaw No. 1, 2025
(Road Closure #23-02, REZ #21-29)

Purpose: to close certain portions of highway – closure of lane allowance to and at the rear of 5650 Beresford Street (portion of lane dedicated by Plan 2775 in District Lot 97, Bocks 16 and 24, Group 1, New Westminster District containing 707.1m²) as shown outlined on Reference Plan EPP133492 prepared by Jesse Morin, B.C.L.S., and repeal Burnaby Highway Closure Bylaw No. 8, 2023, Bylaw No. 14623.
