UPDATE: Sperling Avenue full closure

Sperling Avenue roadworks between Sprott Street and Joe Sakic Way are scheduled to enter a full road closure starting July 27 and continuing until early November. Despite the closure, access to and from the Sperling parking lot will be maintained at all times. Bill Copeland Sports Centre will remain open for selected activities and allotments.

Please follow all posted signage and traffic control directions when accessing the area. Thank you for your patience and cooperation during this work.

- **Location:** Sperling Avenue between Sprott Street and Joe Sakic Way
- **Expected duration:** July 27 to early November 2026
- **Purpose:** Utility work related to the Burnaby Lake Recreation Centre



About the project

The City of Burnaby is constructing the new Burnaby Lake Recreation Centre adjacent to the Bill Copeland Sports Centre. This major community investment will replace the aging CG Brown Memorial Pool and Burnaby Lake Ice Rink with a modern facility featuring a 50-metre competition pool, 25-metre pool, leisure pool, and an NHL-sized ice rink.
